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SYDNEY OLYMPIC PARK MASTER PLAN 2030 APPROVED BUSINESS READY TO BUILD AN OLYMPIC CITY

The approval of the much-anticipated [Sydney Olympic Park Master Plan](#) will fire the starting pistol on the transformation of the precinct into a vibrant metropolis of residential, commercial and recreational activity supported by Parramatta Light Rail Stage 2 and Sydney Metro West.

The Sydney Olympic Park Business Association and the Sydney Business Chamber, Western Sydney, have been vocal advocates for the approval and release of the Master Plan and the need to provide certainty to investors in the future of this important growth precinct.

“The green light for the Sydney Olympic Park Master Plan gives businesses the confidence to start further building its exciting future,” said Allison Taylor, Chief Executive Officer of the Sydney Olympic Park Business Association.

“We applaud the NSW Government for its vision and support for the Master Plan and its willingness to partner with the private sector to deliver an enhanced precinct that will sustain a modern lifestyle of living, working and playing within the same community.

“With a multi-billion dollar investment in transport infrastructure projects planned for the Olympic Peninsula, such Parramatta Light Rail Stage 2 and Sydney Metro West, the future for the greater Olympic precinct is only going to rocket up the charts as an enviable destination in which to invest.”

Sydney Business Chamber, Western Sydney Director David Borger said Sydney Olympic Park was finally receiving the attention it deserved after delivering the best Olympic Games in living memory almost 20 years ago.

“It is no secret that the Olympic Peninsula has been held back by connectivity issues and this Master Plan will solve some of the problems plaguing the precinct by improving road access and preparing the groundwork for light rail and metro services in the coming decade,” said Mr Borger.

“We need to ensure the major infrastructure projects planned for the precinct are delivered to meet the needs of the Greater Parramatta and Olympic Peninsula’s growing population and make it a prime location for business to invest and create jobs in Western Sydney.

“There are already some outstanding facilities and amenities at Olympic Park and the approval of the Master Plan ensures the precinct can continue to evolve into a vital, vibrant and bustling area of Sydney,” he said.
